## Day 1: This Too Shall Pass (2 Corinthians 4:17-18)

Scripture: "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal." – 2 Corinthians 4:17-18

Reflection: Remember that our struggles are temporary and are meant to build our character and faith. Just as the seasons change, so do the phases of our lives. Trust in God's eternal perspective, and take comfort in knowing that this moment of trial will pass.

Prayer: Dear Lord, help me to see beyond my current struggles and to trust in Your everlasting plan. Give me strength and patience to endure, knowing that You are working all things for my good. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 2: Trouble Comes to All of Our Houses (John 16:33 )

Scripture: "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." – John 16:33

Reflection: We are all familiar with hardships. Yet, Jesus has reassured us that we can find peace in Him amidst the chaos. By keeping our faith strong, we can navigate through these trials with a sense of hope.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, remind me that You are greater than any trouble I face. Grant me the peace that surpasses all understanding and the courage to face each day with hope and faith. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 3: Trouble Doesn't Last Always (Psalm 30:5)

Scripture: "For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning." – Psalm 30:5

Reflection: God's mercy is profound and His joy is everlasting. While we may experience moments of sorrow, they are always followed by joy and renewal. Hold on to God's promise that joy comes in the morning.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for Your promise of joy after sorrow. Help me to hold on to Your love and mercy, knowing that better days are ahead. Fill my heart with hope and joy. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 4: Trouble Has an Expiration Date (Ecclesiastes 3:1 )

Scripture: "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven." – Ecclesiastes 3:1

Reflection: There is a divine timetable for everything, including our troubles. Trust in God's perfect timing and take comfort in the fact that every difficulty has an end date set by God.

Prayer: Gracious God, help me to trust in Your perfect timing. Give me the patience to wait for Your deliverance and the strength to endure until the end. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 5: Don't Just Go Through, Grow Through (James 1:2-4)

Scripture: "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing." – James 1:2-4

Reflection: Our trials are opportunities for growth. Embrace these moments as chances to develop your faith, patience, and character. Let God work in you and through you during these challenging times.

Prayer: Dear Lord, help me to see my struggles as opportunities for growth. Mold me into the person You want me to be and teach me to rely on Your strength. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 6: Hold On (Galatians 6:9 )

Scripture: "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." – Galatians 6:9

Reflection: Perseverance is key. Hold on to your faith and continue doing good, knowing that in God's perfect timing, you will reap the rewards of your labor.

Prayer: : Heavenly Father, grant me the strength to hold on and continue in Your good work. Encourage my heart and remind me of the blessings that come from perseverance. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 7: Deliver Me - This Is My Exodus (Exodus 14:13-14 )

Scripture: "And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever. The Lord shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace." – Exodus 14:13-14

Reflection: God is our deliverer. Just as He delivered the Israelites from Egypt, He will deliver you from your troubles. Stand firm in your faith and witness His mighty power in your life.

Prayer: Lord, I trust in Your deliverance. Fight my battles for me and bring me out of my troubles. I stand in faith, knowing that You are my protector and provider. In Jesus' name, Amen.
